“Support of Door County Land Trust Purchase of Baudhuin Properties”**


Whereas, the Door County Land Trust has made application to the Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program to assist in the acquisition and permanent protection of approximately 483 acres located in Sections 16, 21 and 22, Township 28 North, Range 27 East, Town of Sevastopol, Door County, Wisconsin, currently owned by Richard Baudhuin, et al., (hereinafter referred to as “Baudhuin Properties”); and

Whereas, the Town of Sevastopol, values its natural areas and recreational opportunities, taking pride in the diversity of the natural environment and wildlife, and with an intent to preserve those amenities for future generations; and


Whereas, the Sevastopol Town Board of Supervisors, on August 22, 2011, unanimously approved and endorsed the steps needed to protect the Baudhuin Properties and make it available to the general public;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, the Sevastopol Town Board supports the Door County Land Trust in its efforts to acquire and preserve the Baudhuin Properties as outlined herein.






