

Resolution No. 03-2010 TB
In Support of National Travel and Tourism Week
May 8 – 16, 2010

WHEREAS, the first full week of May is annually recognized as National Travel and Tourism Week in the United States, a tradition first celebrated in 1984 urging citizens to observe the week with appropriate ceremonies and activities;

WHEREAS, travel and tourism is one of America's largest industries with over \$770 billion in direct travel expenditures and is one of America's largest employers with over 7.7 million direct travel-related jobs;

WHEREAS, Door County is a year-round travel destination and has been a popular vacation retreat for over a century;

WHEREAS, tourism in Door County generated an estimated \$483.9 million in visitor spending in 2008, and Door County employees earned an estimated \$179.2 million in wages and proprietary income generated from tourism and supported 8,471 full-time equivalent jobs in Door County; and

WHEREAS, local government revenues collected as a result of tourism spending amounted to an estimated \$21.9 million;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sevastopol Town Board supports National Tourism Week, May 8 – 16, 2010 and declares Thursday, May 13th as Tourism Day in the Town of Sevastopol.


